Kalispell Planned Parenthood CLOSING!

Planned Parenthood recently announced that they are closing their Kalispell, Montana abortion clinic, located at 795 Sunset Blvd., on November 20th, 2009. According to an [article in the Daily Interlake](#), the clinic is closing for economic reasons. The Interlake quotes Stacy James, president and chief executive officer of [Planned Parenthood of Montana](#), who said the board met a few weeks ago and made "this difficult decision."



The Kalispell Planned Parenthood clinic was also the site of a 40 Days For Life peaceful prayer vigil in the spring of 2009. The [40 Days for Life team in Kalispell](#) is convinced - prayer is powerful, and it works! Karen Trierweiler, the local 40 Days for Life coordinator, had no doubt as to why the clinic is shutting its doors forever. "Our heartfelt pleas to God for an end to abortion here in Kalispell are being answered," she said. "Let us rejoice in our mighty God who has looked down upon His with such great favor."



This fall, September 23rd through November 1st, the 40 Days for Life team in Kalispell is conducting another peaceful prayer vigil outside of the offices of All Families Health Care, a second Kalispell abortion facility. This clinic is located at 1060 N. Meridian Road. The All Families Health Care clinic is operated by Susan Cahill, a physicians assistant, with a long term relationship to Dr. James Armstrong, Dr. Jules Marsh and Planned Parenthood. Dr. Armstrong, now a retired, had a long history of performing abortions in Kalispell and formerly operated the clinic that Planned Parenthood took over approximately four years ago.

It is the hope and prayer of the 40 Days for Life participants that All Families Health Care will also cease to provide abortion services and/or close in the near future. [40 Days for Life](#) is a national community-based campaign that draws attention to the evil of abortion through the use of a three-point program of prayer and fasting, constant vigil and community outreach.
